Phase I - 2005

- Raise privately donated funds in the amount of \$300,000
- A new "Town of Leland" welcome sign
- Use the donated funds for beautification, landscaping and maintenance for the Highway 17-74-76 Interchange at Village Road and Highway 133. The entrance to not only Leland, but Brunswick County as well
- Completion anticipated by December 2005

Phase II - 2006-2007

- Encourage streetscaping plan along with the Village Road widening project
- Improve drainage systems
- Install sidewalks on both sides of Village Road
- Enhance Village Road with street trees, lanterns, park benches
- Park benches
- Complete an overall beautification and face-lift of "The Village of Leland's" main street
