

Electronics Recycling Drop-off Day January 17th

The Town of Leland will be coordinating an electronics recycling drop-off day for area residents on Saturday, January 17, 2015 from 9am-3pm. The event will be held at the Leland Recreation Building at 102 Town Hall Dr. Take this opportunity to recycle your old electronics after the holiday season. We will be accepting several types of electronics including televisions, stereos, computers, monitors, printers, cell phones, tablets and batteries. **We will not be accepting** hazardous waste, paint, white goods, other recyclables, or household garbage. You must be a Brunswick County resident to drop-off electronic recyclables at this event.

Also, as a reminder, the large trash dumpsters at the Town Hall location are not for disposal of public garbage or recyclables. They are for disposal of waste from the Town Hall only.

The following materials may also be disposed of at the **Brunswick County Landfill** year round and free of charge:

aluminum cans; newspaper; #1 (PETE) and #2(HOPE) plastic containers 1 through 7; empty aerosol cans; corrugated cardboard; holiday string lights and electrical cords; green, brown, and clear glass containers; used oil and anti-Freeze; gasoline; lead acid batteries(e.g. automobile batteries), rechargeable batteries and regular batteries; cellular phones and electronics; fluorescent bulbs; used cooking oil and latex paint.
