- 1) Prevent yard waste, sediment, trash, or debris of any kind from entering the storm drainage system
- 2) Keep all ditches and drainageways clear of obstructions so stormwater can flow freely

Debris clogs the stormwater drainage system and pollutes waterways

DO

- Blow yard waste back onto a landscaped or grass area, not into the street or storm drain.
- Grasscycle! Grass clippings can stay on the lawn to provide nutrients and moisture to the soil and reduce fertilizer needs.
- Compost yard waste and use material in plant beds and gardens.
- Collect and contain debris for disposal at a proper debris disposal site.
- Keep all drains, ditches, and drainageways free from obstruction.

DO NOT

- Do not blow, sweep, dump, direct or place yard debris, sediment, or trash into any street, storm drain, ditch, pond, creek, waterway, etc.

ONLY RAIN DOWN THE STORM DRAIN!
