## LCAC Refund, Transfer, & Credit Policy

All Refund requests received in writing 14 days or more in advance of the start date of the program/workshop are entitled to:

- 100% refund, less the Activenet processing fee/credit/transfer **if the department** cancels program; If department cancels, LCAC will contact you. 75% refund/credit or 100% transfer **if Patron/Participant** cancels registration. Transfers must be made for a class during same session.
- Refund/credit/transfer requests received **less than 14 days** prior to the start date of a program will **NOT** be granted. Patrons registering within 14 days of the program are not eligible for refund/credit/transfer if they choose to cancel.
- Refunds for medical reasons requested prior to the start date of a program will be granted at 100%, subject to verification/doctors note.
- A credit on an account may be used by any individual on the same registration account. Credits do **NOT** expire. To use credit call or come to the center so you do NOT incur a processing fee.
- Non-attendance/non-participation in a program does not entitle a patron to a refund.
- Please allow 3-4 weeks for processing. If you paid with a Credit Card it will go back on the card used; cash or check will be sent to you in a check.
