

Founders Park Splash Pad Rules and Regulations

Seasonal Hours of Operation (May to October 6)

9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

For your safety the Splash Pad is under video surveillance and is regularly monitored.

The Town of Leland operates the Splash Pad facility at Founders Park for the enjoyment of our residents and visitors. The Splash Pad is open to the public and is used on a first-come, first-served basis. There are no lifeguards on duty.

- Use of the facility and any Splash Pad features is at your own risk. The Town is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
- Do not drink water from the water feature. The water is recirculated.
- Do not use the Splash Pad if you are ill with a communicable disease. Individuals with open sores, who are sick, or have diarrhea should not enter the Splash Pad area.
- Children shall be supervised at all times. Children under the age of 12 shall not be left unattended.
- Appropriate swimwear must be worn while using the Splash Pad.
- Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained. Diapers must be changed and disposed of outside the Splash Pad area.
- Water shoes are strongly recommended.
- The Splash Pad may be closed at any time due to inclement weather, lightning detection, operational concerns, or maintenance.
- Please vacate the park when conditions call for thunder or lightning.
- Food, beverages, gum, and glass containers are prohibited in the Splash Pad area.
- No pets are allowed in the Splash Pad area, except official service dogs.
- Smoking and the use of tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and vaping devices, is prohibited in the entire park.
- No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, and/or scooters are allowed on the Splash Pad.
- No lawn chairs, beach chairs, or furniture are allowed in the Splash Pad.
- No running, climbing, or hanging on the fence or any of the Splash Pad equipment.
- No beach balls, noodles, balls, bats, or athletic equipment allowed within the Splash Pad.
- No loud music, disturbing noises, or profanity (i.e. please be respectful of others).
- No soaps or dyes are allowed in the Splash Pad.

The Town of Leland reserves the right to amend these rules at any time and to remove a participant/spectator from the park for violating any of the above rules or engaging in illegal, disruptive, or inappropriate behavior.
