The project involves complete demolition of the existing Stage and reconstruction of the Stage with all associated mechanical and electrical systems. Work also includes removal and replacement of adjacent asphalt drives and a concrete dance floor, along with construction of a concrete sidewalk between the Stage and Entrance Pavilion.
