Application for Appointment to the Town of Leland Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee

Over the next 12 to 18 months, the Town of Leland will be creating a comprehensive plan for land use that updates, incorporates, and builds upon land use and transportation plans previously adopted by Leland, while creating the policy framework for intelligent growth over a 25-year planning horizon. The plan will incorporate the following elements that will create the framework for Leland's growth and development:

- Community Assessment – Analysis of population, housing, demographic, and economic trends; projections for population increase and demographic changes
- Natural Resources, Resiliency, and Hazard Mitigation – Analysis of environmental sensitive areas and recommendations for land use patterns that create resiliency against natural disasters
- Historic, Cultural, and Heritage Preservation and Enhancement – Review of historic and cultural resources and recommendations for augmenting these resources and history through future land use
- Land Use and Community Design – Analysis of existing land use and a framework for place-based neighborhood nodes and transects
- Housing – Review of housing needs and trends and recommendations that will create strong neighborhoods that support lifelong housing needs
- Transportation – Recommendations for bicycle and pedestrian facilities, collector streets, street connections, and other transportation infrastructure

The project will be led by staff from Leland's Planning and Inspections Department, with assistance from a qualified consultant team. The Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee (CPAC) will be an integral part of the project by providing input on the elements listed above, as well as the recommendations for how to accomplish the vision created by the plan. Significant public engagement during the project will also help shape the vision and strategies for Leland's growth and development over the next 25 years.

The CPAC will be comprised of seven members, including one member from Leland's Planning Board. The CPAC is anticipated to meet regularly during the project, but no more than once per month. The time of day at which meetings will occur will be coordinated after the CPAC members are selected, so as best to accommodate CPAC members' schedules. Therefore, meetings will not necessarily be held during the day but could occur in early evenings.
