



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Where is the recycling center located?

The center is located adjacent to Town Hall and Founders Park at 114 Perry Avenue, Leland, NC 28451.

What are the hours of operation?

The center is open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

What type of recyclables are accepted?

Acceptable materials include paper, cardboard, plastic, glass, and metal. Please refer to the Town of Leland Recycling Guide located at <https://www.townofleland.com/trash-recycling> for a comprehensive list of items.

Items that are not accepted include the following.

- Plastic Bags
- Shredded Paper (bagged or non-bagged)
- Styrofoam
- Household trash
- Disposable food trays, cups or cutlery
- Receipts
- Hardcover books
- Clothing or fabric
- Dishes or cookware (plates, cups, ceramics)
- Electronics
- Light bulbs
- Hazardous waste
- Liquid waste (paint, cleaners, etc.)
- Garden hoses
- Window or mirror glass
- Tires
- Construction debris or yard waste

Please note, leaving items on the ground is considered *ILLEGAL DUMPING*.

Who can use the facility?

The center is for use by Town of Leland residents only.

Are businesses located in the Town of Leland allowed to use the facility?

The facility is for RESIDENTIAL use only. Businesses should contact Brunswick County Operations Services, or a 3rd party hauler for recycling options.

Is there staff on site at the facility?

The center is an unstaffed, self-service facility. Please be mindful of the rules and regulations when using the site, as it is monitored by Town of Leland Police Department. Cameras are used to monitor activities on site.
